

**ACTIVITY REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF JANUARY 2009**

**THE FOLLOWING HEARINGS AND/OR MEETINGS DURING THE MONTH OF JANUARY 2009:**

**Wednesday, January 14, 2009** – The Committee held its organizational meeting of the Committee for the 111<sup>th</sup> Congress. The Committee adopted the committee rules for the 111<sup>th</sup> Congress, the number and jurisdiction of each of the standing subcommittees, the number of majority and minority Members of each of the standing subcommittees. Chairman Waxman announced the chairs and majority membership of each of the standing subcommittees. Resolutions offered by Ranking Member Barton regarding the ranking minority member and minority membership of each of the standing subcommittees were adopted.

**Thursday, January 15, 2009** – The Committee held a hearing entitled “The U.S. Climate Action Partnership” at 9:15 a.m. in room 2123 Rayburn House Office Building.

**Thursday, January 22, 2009** – The full Committee met in open markup session to consider **H.R. 629**, the “Energy and Commerce Recovery and Reinvestment Act”. Subsequently, the Committee ordered H.R. 629 favorably reported to the House, amended, by a voice vote.

**THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS BY THE COMMITTEE ON ENERGY AND COMMERCE ALSO OCCURRED DURING THE MONTH OF JANUARY 2009:**

**Wednesday, January 14, 2009** – H.R. 2, the Children’s Health Insurance Program Reauthorization Act of 2009, was passed by the House by a record vote of 289 – 139. The Committee on Energy and Commerce, together with the Committee on Ways and Means, managed the bill during House floor consideration.

**Monday, January 26, 2009** – Filed House Report 111-7, Part I, to accompany **H.R. 629**, the Energy and Commerce Recovery and Reinvestment Act. This bill was later superseded by H.R. 1.

**Wednesday, January 28, 2009** – **H.R. 1**, the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, was passed the House by a record vote of 244 – 188. Certain energy, health, and telecommunications provisions contained in **H.R. 629**, as reported by the Committee on Energy and Commerce were made part of H.R. 1.


