- Thursday, April 8, 2010** — The Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests and Public Lands held a Joint Oversight Field Hearing with the Subcommittee on Water and Power on "On the Edge: Challenges Facing Grand Canyon National Park."
- Saturday, April 10, 2010** — The Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests and Public Lands held an Oversight Field Hearing on "Losing Ground: The War on Buffelgrass in the Sonoran Desert."
