## COMMITTEE ON STANDARDS OF OFFICIAL CONDUCT

### March 2010

The Committee continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules and standards of official conduct. (An enumeration of those laws and rules is found in H. Rep. 110-938, *Summary of Activities, One Hundred Tenth Congress, A Report of the Committee on Standards of Official Conduct*, 110<sup>th</sup> Cong., 2d Sess. (Jan. 3, 2009).) As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. The Committee received 35 requests for advisory opinions in March of 2010.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives of the 111<sup>th</sup> Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve privately sponsored, officially connected travel. The Committee received 223 such requests in March of 2010.

In addition, the Committee is required under the House rules to offer annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer, and employee of the House. Such training is mandatory for all House officers and employees, and new officers or employees must receive training not later than 60 days after beginning service to the House. The Committee continued to provide such training in March of 2010. The Committee provided training sessions attended by 121 individuals in March of 2010.

The Committee continued to fulfill its investigatory responsibilities, and publicly announced action with respect to one investigation.

Representative Eric Massa. On March 4, 2010, the Committee announced that the Committee, pursuant to Committee Rule 18(a), is investigating and gathering additional information concerning matters related to allegations involving Representative Eric Massa.
