COMMITTEE ON STANDARDS OF OFFICIAL CONDUCT

May 2010

The Committee continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules and standards of official conduct. (An enumeration of those laws and rules is found in H. Rep. 110-938, *Summary of Activities, One Hundred Tenth Congress, A Report of the Committee on Standards of Official Conduct*, 110th Cong., 2d Sess. (Jan. 3, 2009).) As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. The Committee received 21 requests for advisory opinions in May of 2010.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives of the 111th Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve privately sponsored, officially connected travel. The Committee received 117 such requests in May of 2010.

In addition, the Committee is required under the House rules to offer annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer, and employee of the House. Such training is mandatory for all House officers and employees, and new officers or employees must receive training not later than 60 days after beginning service to the House. The Committee continued to provide such training in May of 2010. The Committee provided training sessions attended by 138 individuals in May of 2010. The Committee also continued to provide training online, through a number of training videos. The Committee continued to fulfill its investigatory responsibilities.
